The National School Plant Management Association (NSPMA) scholarship provides financial assistance to individuals attending accredited two or four year college or university where the student/applicant's learning is focused on studies in the area of building design, building construction, building engineering and facility maintenance. The NSPMA scholarship committee will serve as the awards committee and will judge submitted scholarship applications. Awardees will be notified and awarded in May of 2017.
